## DID YOU KNOW?

**Did you know** the windows at Olivet are quite unique and enable those who are not familiar with our church to easily identify our building? The windows were made from four different sizes of sewer tile, cut and set in concrete. The tile is glazed with colored glass, adding a special beauty to both the interior and exterior of the church.

Many look at those little round windows as symbols of the people in this congregation. Each one is slightly different and unique. Some of the windows have lines symbolic of the people who come to us broken and hurt. From sewer tiles to beautiful sanctuary lights, from a manger birth to an empty tomb. God fashions that which is ordinary to extraordinary, from brokenness we are restored to wholeness and called the people of God. We are the church. And this is Olivet, a symbol of warmth and rugged strength.
