Sounds From Home

Over Thanksgiving weekend, our program centers around our complex and ever-evolving sense of home. Dvořák wrote his *American* String Quintet after moving to the United States, blending Czech influences with popular American music. The program also features excerpts from Florence Price's String Quartet No. 2, infused with African dances and Black idioms of the mid-20th century. Principal Flute Julia Bogorad-Kogan performs a solo work by James Lee III, inspired by his long relationship with Brazilian music. Composer Chen Yi was born in Guangzhou, China and settled in the United States, where she is a Professor of Composition at University of Missouri-Kansas City. To come full circle, Dr. Chen will write a new work for Principal Oboe Cassie Pilgrim, whose family hails from the same region of China.
