### **Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update**

As we scale up our operations within the church, we continue to encourage those who enter the building to take steps to reduce the risk of contracting and/or spreading COVID-19.

Many of the community groups and organizations that used the Olivet building prior to COVID have started meeting again and we are excited to be offering in-person vacation bible school this summer.

Our summer worship schedule is as follows:

**In-person services:** Sundays at 9 a.m. and Wednesdays at 5:45 p.m.

**Online:** Live at 9 a.m. on Sunday mornings and available any time after

**Radio:** Sundays at 10 a.m. on WDAY 970 AM

**To comply with CDC guidance, we ask that you please observe the following recommendations when in the building:**

- **If you are fully vaccinated, you may gather without a mask**
- **If you are not fully vaccinated, masks are strongly encouraged for indoor activities and gatherings.**

A few additional items to note:

- The offering plate will continue to remain near the door as you exit the Sanctuary for the foreseeable future.
- Worship bags for children will be returned to the Sanctuary for use. We ask that you please place used worship bags in the bin as you exit the Sanctuary so they can be properly cleaned between uses.
- Our nursery is open, with additional safety and screening precautions in place, during the Sunday morning worship service.
- Donuts and coffee will continue to be served "to-go" on Sunday mornings so they can be enjoyed outdoors whenever possible.
- Bibles and hymnals have been returned to the pews.

What hasn't changed:

- Please continue to stay home if you are not feeling well.
- We will continue to practice social distancing, frequent hand washing, and limit physical contact.
- Masks are still available at each entrance.
- Please continue to be respectful of others and take a courteous approach. Remember, masks protect others.
